Artists, your challenge:

Use your creative expression to produce a work of art which highlights the carnation and Alliance, including but not limited to any of the following:

- Demonstrate the virtues of the carnation
- Its impact on society
- The people associated with it
- The efforts involved in its cultivation

AND ideally the entry/work of art will inspire the observer in some way. **(requested but not required)**

A Few Examples:

A drawing of Levi Lamborn cultivating his carnations. The look and posture of Lamborn communicates the passion he has for this endeavor.

Painting of a young child watching the Carnation parade holding a carnation and staring as the American Flag passes by.

A fictional story about how a visit from someone and the gift of a carnation flower helps an elderly man feel better about his terminal illness.

Entry Categories

- * Painting * Writing (includes short story, poem or song) * Drawing * Mixed Media * Sculpture * Photo *
(No floral arrangements)



Carnation Creations Art Show Rules

This is a juried art show with local judges. Each entry must refer to Alliance and the carnation either visually or in writing. The Scarlet Carnation is preferred but not required.

Each entry must be created by the entrant and demonstrate the virtues of the carnation or its impact on society, the people associated with it or efforts involved in its cultivation.

Please submit entry forms by July 8.

Artist name and Title of work must accompany each entry.

Contestants may enter 1 entry per category.

Each entry must be designated to one category. If the entrant does not select a category the admissions council will select one.

Size Limit – 2'x3' Weight Limit – 50lbs

Entry admissions reserves the right to decline any entry that is deemed inappropriate for public viewing.

All entries will be displayed for public viewing at the Lamborn Carnation Museum located at Beech Creek Gardens during the entire length of the Carnation Festival August 1-11, 2019.

We will begin taking entries on Monday, July 22, 2019 @ 10 am.

Entry deadline is Friday, July 26, 2019, 4:00 pm.

Pick up date – between August 12-16 between the hours of 10:00 am-4:00 pm.

Age/Skill Levels:

*Youth - Age 8-14

*Professional Adult

*Adult - 15 & Up

Judging Criteria - Each entry will be scored from 1-5 on each of the following criteria.

*Originality

*Inspiring Message

*Clear Message

*Use of the Media
